
Step 1: Join Classes


Students can easily navigate between classes by using the menu button.







In order to join a class, students can accept the invitation sent by his or her teacher, or can enter the class code.















Step 2: Submit Assignments






















Students can also access, complete, and turn in their assignments from the class Stream.






Once the teacher has graded and returned the submitted assignment, the student may access his or her grade on the "Assignments" page.




Step 3: Communicate







